# WINTER, WHITE, MEASURING TIME, AND HEALTHY BODIES



## Concerning snowy weather

We will follow **Conrad Weiser's** schedule. Check the websites, TV, or radio.

- **School cancelled** for Weiser means no Preschool for us.
- **Weiser 2-hr. Delay** --we will have Preschool at the normal time if the walks and parking lot are cleared and free of ice. We will call you by 8:30 a.m. if they are not.

We will try to pick up activities, on the next school day, which we would have done on the snowy day. For example, if we miss school on a Thursday, then we will have Show and Tell on Monday.



However, we will keep the **Snack Calendar** as scheduled. If your child is scheduled for snack on a snowy day, we will give your child a snack day the following month.

WEEK 1 (1/3,4) What better time than the New Year to study how we measure time! During the month of January and into February we continue (from November and Healthy Foods) to take a look at keeping our bodies healthy: Exercise, Keep clean, Eat right, and Sleep tight!

WEEK 2 (1/8,10-12) We will talk about different parts of our bodies, including a review of our five senses. (Each week we will highlight one of our Senses in Show & Tell. We begin with the sense of Hearing next week.) We begin our discussions of the brain, how it relates to using our senses, and the many different ways we are smart. Also, our Time feature will be a review of the months. Our color for Show & Tell is White.

WEEK 3 (1/17-19) No school on Monday in observance of Martin Luther King Day. We will have Listen & Tell (try to help your child find an object with a distinctive sound the rest of us can identify without using our eyes (a bell that rings, rather than an electronically produced sound). We will talk about the importance of rest and sleep.

WEEK 4 (1/22,24-26) We learn about fighting germs and the importance of keeping our skin clean.

For Smell & Tell help children find an object with a familiar, natural smell, ie: a small sample of powdered cinnamon rather than a cinnamon candle. Look for objects with distinctive smells--burnt toast! Our Time feature will be a review of the Seasons.

WEEK 5 (1/29,31,2/1) Time is also measured in Days, Hours, and Minutes. Our color is Pink, as we look forward to February.

Soon our Grocery Store Center will change to a Discovery Center science laboratory where children use their five senses to explore objects and conduct experiments.
